



Session 2: Lead Well

In this week's video, you were challenged to lead well. Moses' mother must have been a brave woman to risk death by stepping out against the king's law to choose life for her son. Her actions were an overflow of her commitment to God in her heart. Because she was deeply surrendered to the Lord and trusted Him fully, she was able to teach her other children about following God no matter what. This week, you'll explore the most important thing you can do in leaving a legacy of faith to your children. Leading your children to love God begins in your heart.

1. Read the key scripture passages for this study.

Exodus 2:1-10

Hebrews 11:23-27

2. *In what way can you see Moses' mother, Jochabed, fully committed to God?

3. Read the following verses about loving God and write the main thought for each one.

Matthew 22:34-40

Luke 10:27

4. *What is the most important thing we can do regarding our spiritual legacy? Why does it matter?

5. *The video mentions this statement. *“You can’t lead your children to a place you’ve never been.”* Reflect on your personal relationship with Christ. Are you actively pursuing a vibrant walk with Him? In what ways are your children affected by your commitment (or lack of) to God? Can you see the same attitude toward God in the heart of your children?

6. Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9. Where must God’s commands be first?

7. *What is our responsibility to our children regarding God’s Word? (Deuteronomy 6:4-9)

8. When should we teach our children about God? (Deuteronomy 6:4-9)

9. Read these scriptures about living for God. Write the main thought for each one.

Romans 12:1-2

Colossians 3:1-3

10. *How do those scriptures challenge you to deepen your love and commitment to God?

11. *Consider what you need to begin doing to strengthen your relationship with Jesus and better equip you to lead your children to the heart of God. Check any that apply.
